



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**  
**Between**  
**JOINT FACULTY OF VETERINARY MEDICINE**  
**KAGOSHIMA UNIVERSITY, KAGOSHIMA,**  
**JAPAN**  
**and**  
**FACULTY OF VETERINARY MEDICINE**  
**UNIVERSITAS AIRLANGGA, SURABAYA,**  
**INDONESIA**



In order to encourage academic exchange and collaboration between our two faculties, and to advance teaching and research, Joint Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Kagoshima University, Kagoshima, Japan and Faculty of Veterinary Medicine Universitas Airlangga, Surabaya, Indonesia have entered into this Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “MoA”) to create a foundation from which such collaboration may be developed.

**Article I.**

The Parties share a mutual intent to support and promote the spirit of this MoA by encouraging cooperation and collaboration as follows:

1. Exchange of teaching and research personnel;
2. Exchange of respective staff for research, teaching and students;
3. Establishment of joint research projects on subjects of mutual interest.

**Article II.**

Cooperative activities and exchange of research, teaching and publication will be developed when appropriate to the interests of the Parties in accordance with permissible financial circumstance. In any cooperative activities under this memorandum, each faculty will be primarily responsible for financially supporting its own involvement in the activities.

**Article III.**

The Parties recognize that the cooperative and collaborative activities referred to above will need to be conducted by way separate, written agreements. Those agreements will set out the Parties’ various rights and obligations in respect of those activities.

**Article IV.**

This MoA will be signed as two originals in English and Bahasa Indonesia by both parties. Both parties agree that these duplicate versions are authentic. In the event of any divergence of interpretation between any of the texts, the English text shall prevail.

**Article V.**

This MoA will commence on the date it is signed by representatives of both Parties and shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years. This MoA shall be extended for a further 5 (five) years at the expiration date unless either Party gives written notice to determine this MoA at least 3 (three) months prior to the expiration date.

**Article VI.**

This MoA may be amended or terminated in writing at any time by mutual consent. For the amendment or termination, either party should give 6 (six) months’ notice in writing to the other

party. Any difference or dispute arising out of the interpretation, implementation or application of the provisions of this MoA will be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation between the Parties without reference to any third party or international tribunal.

#### Article VII.

Any communication under this MoA will be in writing in the English delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimile number of the Parties as the case may be, shown below or to such other address or electronic mail address or facsimile number as either Party may have notified the sender.


